### **CAPE GRACE, CAPE TOWN**

Occupying a prime location in the heart of the V&A Waterfront, Cape Grace is an elegant and luxurious property. The hotel sits on a private quay, with views over the colourful marina. Standards of service are superb but low key, ensuring a relaxed atmosphere. There are 120 guest rooms designed with traditional, tasteful décor with an emphasis on comfort. Finishing touches such as hand-painted fabrics and crafted metalwork are everywhere. There is also a cosy library filled with leather chairs, a superb restaurant, and a lively whisky and wine bar overlooking the harbour.

### **FOUR ROSMEAD, CAPE TOWN**


Four Rosmead is a stylish boutique guesthouse with just eight rooms. Sitting on the slopes of Table Mountain, it has landscaped gardens with a solar-heated saltwater swimming pool and a massage treatment room. Inside, the lounge is filled with sofas and large fireplaces, leading into the airy breakfast room. The contemporary interiors are filled with South African artwork, and the rooms are decorated with a mix of modern and French design. Several have views over Table Mountain or the city. Owner David and his team attend to your every need to ensure your stay is truly relaxing.

### **ABBAY MANOR, CAPE TOWN**

Built in 1904, this charming owner-managed guesthouse retains many original features, including intricate stained glass windows. Abbey Manor is situated on the foothills of Table Mountain, offering superb views on a clear day, particularly from the Jacuzzi on the roof terrace. There is a comfortable lounge, an airy breakfast room and a solar-heated swimming pool and sun deck. Each of the nine rooms retains its own character, and all are well-appointed and decorated with a mix of traditional and modern furnishings.

### **I ON QUEENS, CAPE TOWN**

I on Queens has a superb position high on the slopes of Signal Hill, offering sweeping views over the city and up towards Table Mountain. The surroundings are peaceful and residential, with shops and cafés on Kloof Street just a short walk away. There are nine guest rooms, modern in their design and some have balconies to enjoy vistas of the city or mountain. Breakfasts are served on the terrace, overlooking the swimming pool and tranquil gardens. This is a great value option in a lovely neighbourhood of the city.

### **CAMPS BAY RETREAT, CAPE TOWN**

Set amongst vast manicured gardens, Camps Bay Retreat is a peaceful base in the quaint Camps Bay district. The Manor house has four suites decorated in an elegant, colonial style. A suspension bridge over a steep ravine links the grounds to the more contemporary rooms in the gardens. Guest facilities include a tennis court, three swimming pools and use of a nearby spa. There are various dining options within walking distance and the hotel also offers dinners at its restaurant, the Retreat Kitchen.

### **WATERFRONT VILLAGE APARTMENTS, CAPE TOWN**

This collection of luxury self-catering apartments is situated in the heart of the popular V&A Waterfront. They range in size from one to four bedrooms and in degree of luxury from standard to penthouse. Each includes an en suite bathroom, kitchen, sitting area with satellite TV and DVD player and a washing machine. Many have views over the Waterfront Canal or Table Mountain. There is on-site secure parking, a gym and five swimming pools. The apartments are a good option for travellers seeking independence and their location is superb.
